JOB DESCRIPTION

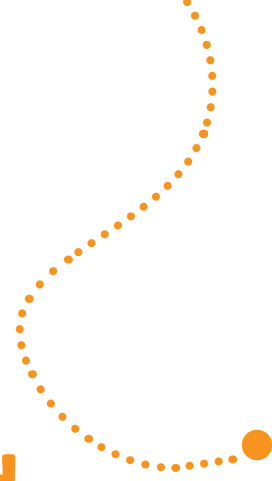
As a Sr/Carbon Business Developer you are responsible for carbon measurement and analysis for various assignment which includes GHG accounting and impact assessment. You will advise FairClimateFund's client on NetZero climate strategy to fairtrade CO2 compensation. Your focus will be to document the carbon methodologies (Gold Standard, fairtrade climate standard, VERRA, Plan Vivo, others) knowledge into simple analysis and reporting for the private sector clients. Through advisory and consulting support, you will ensure that our customers become our ambassadors, to help us realize our ambitions in the field of social and environmental impact. You will report to the Director India of FairClimateFund. The position will be based out of India with occasionally travel (20%) within the country and outside.
